

# Offley Wider Curriculum Lesson Structure

## Retrieve



- ★ A question or activity to consolidate previous learning.
- ★ The pupils practise a skill or recall knowledge related to the subject.
- ★ Pupils to recall/retrieve learning from different periods of time - last lesson, last term or last year.
- ★ How does today's lesson fit into the sequence of learning?
- ★ What skills do the pupils use in the subject? Share the skills.

## Learn



- ★ Start with a question.
- ★ Star words (vocabulary)
- ★ What skills and knowledge are being learnt?
- ★ Exposition is clear and builds on prior knowledge.
- ★ Reading opportunities.
- ★ Modelling - 'I do, we do, you do'.
- ★ Pupils to show their learning in a variety of ways - voice notes, sorting (all children can access)
- ★ Purposeful opportunities - why are we learning this?

## Apply



- ★ Use technology effectively and creatively to innovate learning.
- ★ Specific knowledge and skills linked to the subject area.
- ★ Outcome specifically linked to the focus of the lesson.
- ★ Provide WAGOLL.
- ★ Live marking and feedback throughout.

## Reflect



- ★ Exit question, task or quiz - use technology creatively.
- ★ Linked to the unit outcomes.
- ★ Assessment
- ★ Upload work to Showbie.
- ★ Feedback and marking.
