We would like to remind all parents and carers to ensure that their ParentPay accounts remain in credit for school lunches. Recently, we have seen balances falling and an exceptionally high number of accounts moving into arrears.

As we approach the end of the academic year, it is important that all outstanding balances are cleared before we close for the summer holidays. This includes any fees owed for The Zone as well as school lunches.

Any credit remaining on children's accounts will automatically roll forward to their new year group in September. The exception to this is Year 6 pupils, whose accounts should be checked and any remaining credit dealt with before they leave.
