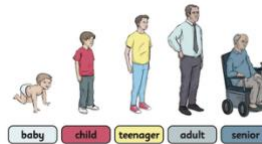

Key Knowledge:

Know That animals have offspring

- To describe how adults including humans have offspring which grow into adults.
- Use appropriate names for the stages in a life cycle.
- Know to survive animals needs water, air, food and a suitable habitat.

Key Skills

- Ask questions and use secondary sources to find out about the life cycles of some animal.
- Observe animals growing over a period of time.
- Ask questions of parent/pet owners about how they look after their baby/pets.

Survive - to stay alive

Basic Needs - The important things animals need to to survive (air, water, food, shelter)

Change - when something becomes different.

Observe - to look closely.

Life cycle - the stages an animal goes through in its lifetime.

Adult- fully grown animal.

Offspring - the babies that an animal produces.

Reproduce - to produce offspring.

Live young - offspring born alive.

Hatchling - an offspring that has hatched from an egg.
